ONWARDS

ONWARDS is a global programme of clinical studies to investigate how well a new insulin taken once weekly, insulin icodec, controls blood sugar in people with diabetes. Once-weekly insulin icodec will be compared with insulins taken once daily, which are already available on the market.

As part of the programme, this study is comparing the effect and safety of once-weekly insulin icodec (when switching from a daily basal insulin) with once-daily insulin glargine U100, over a period of ~9 months.

You may qualify for this study if you are an adult with type 2 diabetes and are currently receiving treatment with a once- or twice-daily basal insulin.
