

**Will the vaccine be safe for pregnant women and women trying to conceive?**

**A:** Pregnant women and women trying to conceive were not included in the first round of clinical trials for the COVID-19 vaccines, so no safety data is currently available for these groups. However, CDC recommends that pregnant women consider their personal risk of contracting COVID-19 by occupation or other activities, risk of COVID-19 to her and her pregnancy, efficacy of the vaccine, and known side effects of the vaccine when deciding whether to be vaccinated. Pregnant women and women trying to conceive should have a discussion with their healthcare provider about risks and benefits of the COVID-19 vaccine.
